■ Due to a St Albans district wide review by the Electoral Commission, there will be major changes to some of the wards and a cut in the number of District councillors from 58 to 56.

As a consequence, new wards will be created, and some will disappear.

In the final recommendations, Napsbury Park will join Park Street Ward.
